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ELT+V enters its next phase as a project after teachers' and volunteers' successful pilots of the training materials.

On the 4th of April 2022, the consortium of ELT+V met in Reus, Spain, for a 2-days meeting, hosted by Open Europe. The partners discussed the progress of the project and agreed on the next steps.

During the meeting, the partners had the chance to review the evaluations of the teachers and volunteers that participated in the "train-the-trainers" event in Lecco, Italy, during October 2021. These evaluations were the aftermath of the national pilotings. Partners had requested the trainers to test the materials of all five modules with their own students and provide feedback through a specialized questionnaire.

Partners collected the feedback from teachers and volunteers, they analyzed their responses, the effect of the activities on the students, and also the strengths and weaknesses of the 5 training modules. Also, they highlighted all the needed adjustments and improvements that need to be done on the training modules. This is an important step so the partnership can deliver a final, tested product.

Next on the meeting's agenda was the implementation of the second phase of the project. The consortium discussed about the next steps that they need to follow to ensure the effectiveness of the second project result.

Specifically, the discussion of this topic was based on how to develop and finalize the online handbook which will support the upskilling in teaching national languages to refugees and migrants.

The partners designed collectively the way that the online handbook is going to be presented to the public. They unanimously agreed on a specific template which is going to be developed in order to be used for the creation of the online handbook.

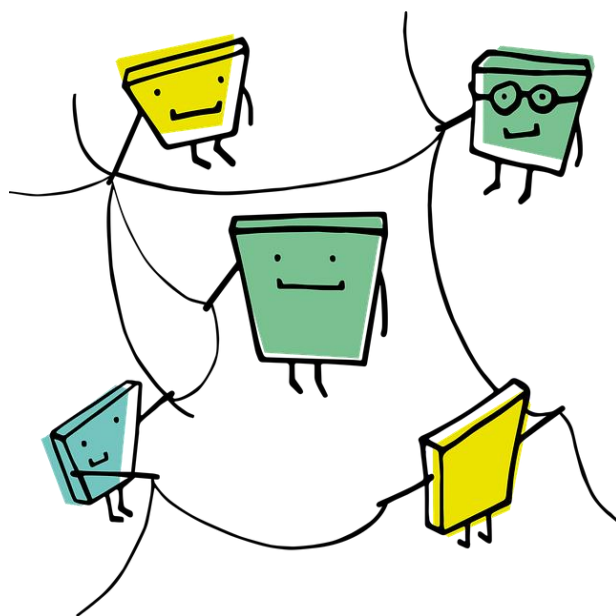
