MULTIPLIER EVENTS

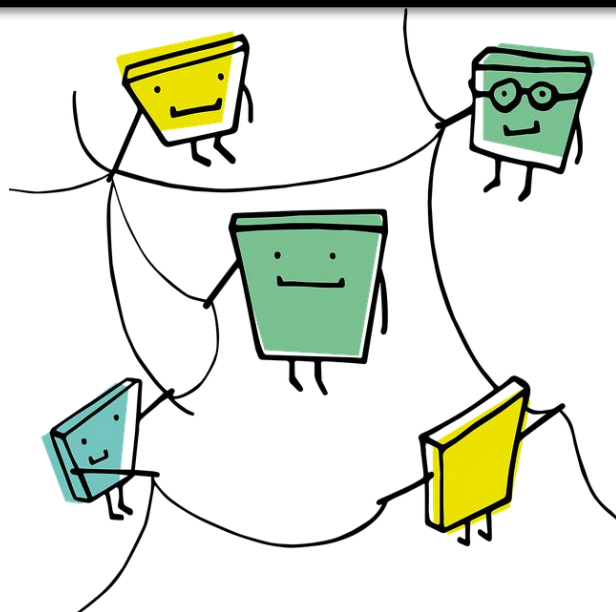
